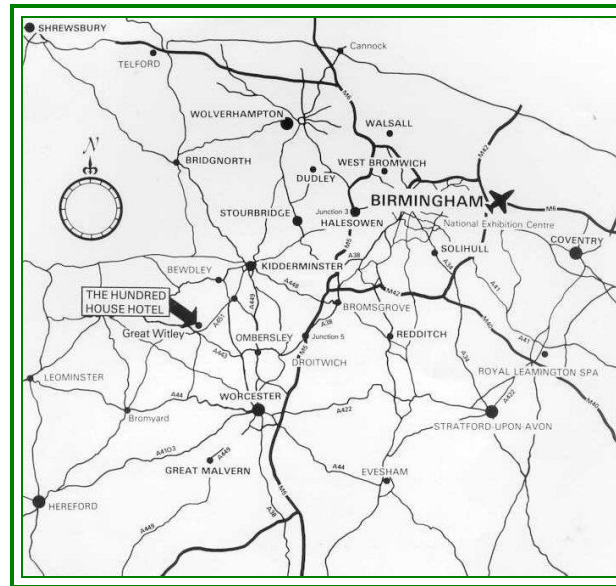

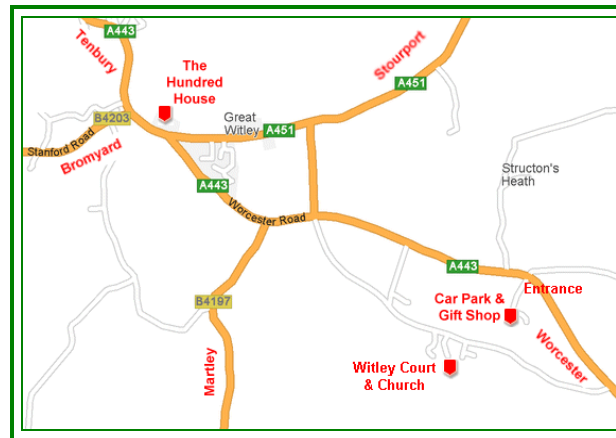

Programme

Participants will be welcome for all or part of the weekend and will be able to choose between staying at The Hundred House Hotel or making their own arrangements.

Friday 18th May afternoon:

2pm Visit to Witley Court and Church, Great Witley, Worcestershire. A hundred years ago it was the splendid home of the Earls of Dudley, with the profits of their coal and limestone mines in the Black Country lavished on it. We visited it in 2002 but it is worth a return to see the fountain and garden features that have since been restored. You can explore the house and gardens at your own pace with a personal audio tour. Adjoining is "England's Finest Baroque Church" the stunning interior of which was created by the Foley family, ironmasters of Stourbridge, who owned the Court before the Wards.

4pm Cream tea in the Garden Tea Rooms, Great Witley. Set in Lady Dudley's private topiary garden our tea will be laid out for us in the Conservatory.
